APPLICANT SIGNATURE

LEAD FREE NOTICE

The State Construction Code Act, No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, requires pipes, pipe fittings, solder or flux, which are used in the installation or repair of a plumbing system in a building or structure, providing water for human consumption or a public water system, to be lead free. Lead free is defined as solder or flux containing not more than 0.2% lead, and pipe and pipe fittings containing not more than 8% lead. These provisions do not apply to leaded joints necessary for the repair of cast iron pipes.

FEE CLARIFICATION

ITEM #2, MOBILE HOME UNIT SITE. WHEN item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee plus the number of unit sites. WHEN setting a mobile home in a park, or a mobile or modular home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, and a water service or water distribution pipe.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Plumbing Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.

When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months.

OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION CANCELED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED
